

UNIFORM POLICY

Students must at all times wear clothing that is in good repair, fits appropriately, is suitable for physical activity, and is appropriate for the viewing of small children (e.g., not displaying rudeness or profanity). Clothes must not reveal a student's undergarments. Crop tops and spaghetti straps are not allowed (even on Fridays). No hats may be worn inside the school. Shoes must be suitable for physical activity and worn at all times while your child is outside. Flip-flops or similar shoes are not permitted.

Monday - Thursday - Students must wear a uniform, as described in detail below.

Fridays - Students may wear clothing of their choice, but they must follow the above guideline for appropriateness. Students will be asked to put on something from the uniform swap if they arrive at school in clothing that does not follow the above guidelines.

A child's first violation of the uniform policy will result in a reminder from a staff member, and the child will find appropriate clothes in the uniform swap to wear that day. The second violation will result in an email to their parents, and the child will find appropriate clothes in the uniform swap to wear that day. A third violation will result in a phone call to the parent to bring in a proper uniform.

Uniform Swap

We accept uniforms that your child has outgrown as long as they are clean and in good repair. We add these to a closet at school that parents and students can "shop" from (and donate to) free of charge, twice a year. Please only donate school uniform items that follow the guidelines and have no tears or stains.

Uniform Policy

Shirts

Solid white, navy, or Carolina blue collared shirts or TNCA t-shirts purchased from the school must be worn.

Any shirt layered underneath a uniform shirt must be solid white, navy, or Carolina blue.

Not Permitted

Tank tops, spaghetti straps, sleeveless shirts, crop tops.

Pants

Solid navy blue cotton twill, knit, corduroy, or comparable fabric must be worn.

Not permitted

Denim, sweatpants, leggings as pants, yoga pants, joggers, mesh or athletic wear, pants with patterns or prints.

Sweaters and Sweatshirts

Solid white, navy, or Carolina blue sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn in the classroom.

Sweaters bought from Lands End with TNCA embroidery on them are permitted.

Sweatshirts purchased from the school with the TNCA logo on them are permitted.

Not permitted

Sweaters or sweatshirts with logos, patterns, or prints.

Skirts and Jumpers

Solid navy blue cotton twill, knit, corduroy, or comparable fabric must be worn.

Skirts, dresses, jumpers, kilts, and skorts must be a minimum length of mid thigh, and bike shorts, tights, or leggings should be worn underneath.

Leggings or tights worn underneath a skirt or jumper must be solid navy blue.

Dresses must have a collar on them.
Jumpers must be worn with a collared shirt underneath.

Not permitted

Carolina blue dresses or jumpers.

Outerwear

Students are encouraged to have appropriate outerwear as they spend a minimum of 1.5 hours outside daily. Weather can range from very cold to very warm.

Any style or color jacket or coat may be worn outside, but may not be worn in the classroom unless it is solid white, navy, or Carolina blue. Please refer to the guidelines for sweaters and sweatshirts for items that can be worn in the classroom.

Shorts

Solid navy blue cotton twill, knit, corduroy, or comparable fabric must be worn.

Shorts must have a 4-inch minimum inseam.

Pull-on elastic waist shorts and golf shorts are permitted but must follow guidelines.

Not permitted

Athletic shorts of any kind which include but are not limited to running shorts, gym shorts, basketball shorts, mesh shorts, sweatpant shorts, and quick dry shorts.

Shoes and Accessories

Any shoe that your child can run and play in is permitted. Belts and socks can be any color or style.

Not permitted

Flip-flops, sliders, heels over 1 inch, and shoes with a slick bottom such as crocs, which can cause the children to slip and fall.

P.E./Sports

Beginning in 5th grade, students will have P.E. and/or sports practice once a week.

This uniform will be purchased directly from the school and consists of:

Grey TNCA t-shirt, navy shorts, and navy sweatpants.

Students may wear their P.E. uniform all day on P.E. day or change into it before practice.

Uniforms at Lands' End
